**Anne Nelson** is a journalist and playwright and teaches at the School of International and Public Affairs at Columbia University. Ms. Nelson has received numerous awards and grants, including a 2005 Guggenheim Fellowship and a John McCloy Fellowship from the ACG for her book on the culture of German resistance in Berlin, *Red Orchestra: The Story of the Berlin Underground and the Circle of Friends Who Resisted Hitler*, published by Random House in April 2009 and forthcoming in Germany from C. Bertelsmann in 2010.

Her books and articles have been published widely and her play, "The Guys" has been staged throughout the world. As a war correspondent in El Salvador and Guatemala from 1980 to 1983, Ms. Nelson published reports and photography in the *New York Times*, *Los Angeles Times*, and many other publications. She is a graduate of Yale University.
